

KIDS CLUB COMPETITION: Win a trip to Toronto
COMPETITION RULES (the "Rules")

"Kids Club Competition" (the "Competition") is organized by Transat Tours Canada Inc. operating as Air Transat (the "Organiser"). The Competition starts on October 2, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. Montreal time (the "Competition Opening Date"), and ends December 11, 2017, at 11:59 p.m. Montreal time (the "Competition Closing Date").

1. ELIGIBILITY

The Competition is open to all residents of the United Kingdom and Ireland who have reached the age of majority by the Competition Opening Date, except for employees, agents and representatives of the Organizer, its subsidiaries, affiliates, affiliated companies, advertising or promotion agencies, the suppliers of material, prizes and services related to this Competition, and any other stakeholder directly related to the holding of the Competition, as well as the members of their immediate family (father, mother, brothers, sisters, children and legal or de facto spouse) and anyone with whom these employees, representatives and agents reside.

2. HOW TO ENTER

- 2.1. The contestant (the "Contestant" or "Contestants") in order to be eligible to the Competition, must do the following:

3. PRIZES

- 3.1 One (1) prize shall be awarded consisting of four return tickets to Canada for a family (two adults and two children) from the United Kingdom or Ireland (departing and arriving at airports from which we are authorized to operate commercial flights) for travel to Toronto between 10th January and 31st October, 2018, excluding but not limited to school and bank holidays.
- 3.2 The Prize has a maximum value of £2,600.

CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THE PRIZE

- 3.3 The Prize return tickets are subject to the availability of Transat Tours Canada Inc. at the time of reservation. General Terms and Conditions of Transat Tours Canada Inc apply www.airtransat.com. Taxes, airport fees, customs duties, entry fees and tourist cards, surcharges, insurance charges, personal expenses, personal travel insurance and travel documents are not included in the Prize. The Organizer strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance.
- 3.4 The Prize return tickets must be reserved at least 30 days prior to the scheduled date of departure of the outbound flight to Canada.
- 3.5 There are no alternative Prizes. The Prize offered must be accepted as awarded and is not exchangeable, transferable or convertible into cash.

4. SELECTION OF WINNER – PRIZE DRAWS

- 4.1 The random draw will be held from all eligible entries received between the Contest Opening Date (October 2, 2017, 9:00 a.m.) and Closing Date (December 15, 2017, 11:59 p.m., Montreal time). The draw shall be held on December 15, 2017, 9:00 a.m., Montreal time, in the offices of Transat, 300 rue Léo Pariseau, Montréal, Québec, H2X 4C2.

- 4.2 The Winner of the Contest will be the first Contestant selected at random by an independent judge out of all eligible entries. The name of the judge is available on request.

5. PRIZE CLAIM

- 5.1 In order to be declared the winner of the Prize (the "**Winner**"), the selected Contestant must:

5.1.1 Be contactable by email or by telephone by the Organizer within forty-eight (48) hours of the Prize draw. If the Contestant cannot be reached by email or telephone within forty-eight (48) hours from the initial attempted communication by or on behalf of the Organizer, all of their rights to the Prize shall be forfeited and an alternative entry will be randomly drawn. If the second Contestant cannot be contacted by telephone or email within forty-eight (48) hours from the initial attempted communication by or on behalf of the Organizer, all of their rights to the Prize shall be forfeited and an alternative entry will be randomly drawn. If it is impossible to reach the 3rd Contestant by telephone or by email within forty-eight (48) hours from the attempted communication by or on behalf of the Organizer, the Prize shall be deemed forfeited. For the purpose of this clause 6.1.1 contact shall be deemed to have been made with a Contestant if a representative of the Organizer is able to speak by telephone directly with the Contestant (and not via voicemail or any form of automated call service) or the Organizer is satisfied (at its sole discretion) that any email notification sent by the Organizer has been received by the Contestant.

5.1.2 Complete and sign a declaration and liability waiver form (hereinafter the **Waiver Form**) sent by the Organizers and return it to the Organizer within 14 days or such later date as the Organizer may at its sole discretion confirm to the relevant Contestant in writing.

- 5.2 The Winner will be announced within 48 hours of the Organizer receiving the Waiver Form from the Winner in a form acceptable to the Organizer and in accordance with clause 6.1.2.

- 5.3 Upon receipt of the duly completed and signed Waiver Form, the Organizers will contact the Winner in order to inform them on how to take possession of the Prize.

- 5.4 If the Winner fails to observe any of the conditions mentioned above or any other conditions stipulated in these Rules, the selected Winner will be disqualified and the Prize that would have been awarded will be forfeited.

6. PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 6.1 You acknowledge that your name and or image may be required to be used in publicity if you are selected as the Winner.

- 6.2 From time to time, the Organizer, with the Contestant's consent, may use the personal information provided for the purpose of:

6.2.1 Communicating with the Winner so they can take possession of the Prize;

6.2.2 Communicating with the Contestant directly in relation to goods and services offered by the Organizer, including special offers and information on travel services; and

- 7.2 By entering this Contest, the selected Contestant agrees, without receiving any additional compensation, to the use of their name, address, city, province, voice, comments, photographs and/or other likeness for advertising and promotional purposes by the Organizer.
